

Temagami Canoe Trip

Night	
1) June 10 Friday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping on Lake Temagami, North of Adventure Island</p> <p>-Paddle north on Lake Temagami past Ket-Chun-Eny Lodge then northwest along the north shore of Bear Island then north to the northeast corner of Garden Island. Continue northwest toward Adventure Island and camp on sites on west side of Lake Temagami.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 686081 Group 2 Campsite: 686077</i> <i>0 Portages: 0 m Total Portages: 0 m Total Distance Paddled: 10.4 km</i></p>
2) June 11 Saturday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping on Obabika Lake</p> <p>Paddle south into narrow channel next to the Adventure Camp and paddle into Gibson's Bay. Continue into the Northwest Arm along right shoreline and cross over in the narrowest section and continue along the left shoreline into Obabika Inlet. Paddle west to the 810 m portage into Obabika Lake. Paddle northwest to campsites. Group 1 camps on point on west shoreline and Group 2 camps on campsite at Splash Point on east shoreline just north of the portage.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 551131 Group 2 Campsite: 564128</i> <i>1 Portage: 870 m Total Portages: 870 m Total Distance Paddled: 18.6 km</i></p>
3) June 12 Sunday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping on Wakimika Lake (1. In Park)</p> <p>Paddle north on Obabika Lake along eastern shoreline toward top end of the lake. After lunch, paddle west to the mouth of the Wakimika River and paddle upstream until reaching Wakimika Lake. Group 1 is to camp on the island and Group 2 is to camp at island site in southwest corner of the lake.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 503225 Group 2 Campsite: 497217</i> <i>0 Portages: 0 m Total Portages: 0 m Total Distance Paddled: 16.3 km</i></p>
4) June 13 Monday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping on South Lady Evelyn River (2. In Park)</p> <p>Paddle north on Wakimika Lake to the sandy beach. Paddle through the narrows and proceed north east to the 400 m portage into a small lake. Portage along the Red Squirrel logging road. Once on the small lake, paddle to the right and take out at the far end on the left side. Portage 390 m over a rocky portage. Once over the portage, paddle northeast on Diamond Lake. Have lunch on campsite on island on right side of the lake across from the long portage. After lunch, paddle north into the bay and continue north to the end and begin the 2420 m portage into South Lady Evelyn River. Once over the portage, Group 2 to camp at end of portage and Group 1 to paddle to the right and camp on point on north side around the corner.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 542319 Group 2 Campsite: 535318</i> <i>3 Portages: 400 m, 390 m, 2420 m Total Portages: 3210 m Total Distance Paddled: 13.0 km</i></p>
5) June 14 Tuesday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping at Shangra La, Lady Evelyn River (3. In Park)</p> <p>Paddle west and up the river to the first portage. Portage 110 m but this portage can often be walked up rather than carry over. Continue to the 290 m portage which can often be lined on the left. The next portage is called Fat Man's portage. It is only 100 m but is quite steep. After this portage, continue upstream to the 870 m portage on the right side. After the portage, paddle to Bridal Vail Falls. Portage 410 m up a steep slope. The next portage is Cabin Falls and the portage is on the right side of the river and is 320 m. There is an easier portage on the left side beginning with a set of stairs. If no one is at the cabins, we can portage through the site and exit at a small dock at the top end. The next portage is on the right side and is 200 m. After this, the canoes can be lined up the shoreline on the left side. Upon reaching Katherine Lake, if there is time, paddle to the north end of the lake and line the canoes up two swifts. After the second swift, paddle to the end of a small lake and store the canoes at the start of the portage to Shangra La. Camp at the top of the waterfall.</p>

Sunday	<p>then west and then portage 80 m into Goodfish Lake. Paddle southwest to the 1230 m portage into the narrow channel leading to Lady Evelyn Lake. Upon reaching the lake, paddle southwest to campsites on a island and point on shoreline. Camp at these sites tonight.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 623391</i> <i>Group 2 Campsite: 625390</i></p> <p><i>3 Portages: 400 m, 80 m, 1230 m Total Portages: 1710 m Total Distance Paddled: 17.4 km</i></p>
11) June 20 Monday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping on Diamond Lake (8. In Park)</p> <p>Paddle southwest on Lady Evelyn Lake into the narrows at the south end of the lake to the 25 m lift over into Diamond Lake. Portage into Diamond Lake and paddle over to the Pictograph site on the west shoreline just down from the portage on a small cliff face. Upon reaching the islands, head west down the lake and camp on islands just east of the long portage into the Lady Evelyn River. Camp on one of the islands tonight.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 556287</i> <i>Group 2 Campsite: 556283</i></p> <p><i>1 Portage: 25 m Total Portages: 25 m Total Distance Paddled: 16.4 km</i></p>
12) June 21 Tuesday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping on Obabika Lake (9. In Park)</p> <p>Paddle west then southwest to the 390 m portage. After the portage, paddle down a small lake to the far shoreline where there is a sloping rock. This 400 m portage begins by going up the rock and onto the Red Squirrel logging road. Continue down the road and then head down the trail on the left leading down a hill to the lake. Paddle down the lake and out onto Wakimika Lake. Paddle south on the lake to the narrow channel leading to Obabika Lake. Paddle down the Wakimika Creek to Obabika Lake and upon reaching the lake, paddle east across the north end of the lake to the two campsites and camp at this site tonight.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 541197</i> <i>Group 2 Campsite: 539197</i></p> <p><i>2 Portages: 390 m, 400 m Total Portages: 790 m Total Distance Paddled: 18.3 km</i></p>
13) June 22 Wednesday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping on Obabika Lake</p> <p>Hike into the Old Growth Forest to the 3 Sisters tree site in the morning. Paddle south to the spit on the east shoreline about half way down the lake and camp at this site tonight.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 151159</i> <i>Group 2 Campsite: 152159</i></p> <p><i>0 Portage: 0 m Total Portages: 0 m Total Distance Paddled: 4.0 km</i></p>
14) June 23 Thursday	<p style="text-align: center;">Camping on Lake Temagami</p> <p>Paddle to the 870 m portage into Obabika Inlet. Continue east reaching the NW Arm of Lake Temagami. Paddle SE down the NW Arm until reaching the islands at Gibson's Bay. Proceed to the campsites North of the Canadian Adventure Camp and camp here tonight.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: 693082</i> <i>Group 2 Campsite: 693080</i></p> <p><i>1 Portage: 870 m Total Portages: 870 m Total Distance Paddled: 22.1 km</i></p>
15) June 24 Friday	<p style="text-align: center;">Return to Access Point at end of trip</p> <p>Paddle SE on Lake Temagami to the north of Garden Island and Bear Island. Continue South past Temagami Island and finish at the access point just South of Loon Lodge.</p> <p><i>Group 1 Campsite: Home</i> <i>Group 2 Campsite: Home</i></p> <p><i>0 Portage: 0 m Total Portages: 0 m Total Distance Paddled: 10.4 km</i></p>
